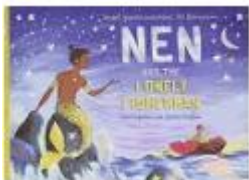

Mathematical Development	This week we will be exploring place value of numbers to 100. <u>We will be learning to:</u> • What do digits mean in two-digit numbers? • Can you compare two-digit numbers? • Can you order numbers? • How can we partition numbers into tens and ones? <u>Words you might hear your child say:</u> • Partition • Greater than/less than/equal to/compare <u>With your child you could:</u> • Count forwards and backwards in ones and tens • Put three numbers in order from greatest to smallest	
Jigsaw	Our unit this term will focus on the theme of 'Being Me in my World'. This week's learning question is: How can I be responsible member of my class and community?	
Geography	This unit will focus on our BIG enquiry question, 'Why should we look after our oceans?' This week we will explore and discuss: • Why are our oceans under threat? • How can we protect our oceans? <u>Vocabulary</u> Ocean, sea, habitat, medicine, oxygen, food, continent, map, globe.	

Physical Development	Jenny will lead a PE session each week and class teachers will lead sessions. We will be learning playground games, as well as exploring a variety of invasion games.
